- 3. Battery compartment

Hardware provided:

- 2 screws
- 2 wall plugs

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Power supply: 3 AA/LR06 batteries (not provided).

- 1. Remove the battery compartment cover by pressing the tab.
- 2. Install the batteries taking care to observe the correct polarities (+ and -) shown inside the compartment.
- 3. Replace the cover.



INSTALLATION

- 1. Choose the outside or inside location where you wish to fit the dummy keypad.

If the keypad is fitted outdoors, position it so that it is protected from extreme weather, heat or damp. Do not expose to rain.

- 2. Mark the positions of the 2 holes to be drilled in the wall.
- 3. Drill the holes using an appropriate drill bit for the substrate.
- 4. If necessary, push the wall plugs provided or other suitable wall plugs into the holes in the substrate.
- 5. Position the keypad on the wall and insert the 2 screws provided.
- 6. Tighten the screws.

OPERATION

In the dark or at night, the light sensor built in to the keypad will switch on the backlighting to make the keys clearly visible.

This product is not a toy. Keep out of the reach of children.

SAFE INSTRUCTIONS FOR BATTERY:

- Never mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) and rechargeable (nickel hydride).
